Application Fee	<p><u>New Families:</u> This <i>nonrefundable fee</i> is paid at the time of initial application.</p> <p><u>Currently Enrolled Families:</u> Application Fees are waived for families with a currently enrolled student in the RCS system as long as the K-12 New Sibling Application is submitted by 2/2/2018 (a \$50 fee will apply for new sibling applications received after this date).</p>	<p>\$150/First Student \$50/Each Sibling <i>due with application</i></p>
Enrollment Fee	<p>This <i>nonrefundable fee</i> is paid yearly, is due at the time of enrollment/re-enrollment, and holds the student's class placement.</p> <p><u>New Families:</u> New Student Application must be submitted by 3/1/18 to receive <i>PRIORITY</i> enrollment fee discount of \$250 (for new families enrolling a first child in grades K-12). Applications received after 3/1/18 and on or before 5/1/18, will receive a \$100 enrollment fee discount.</p> <p><u>Currently Enrolled Families:</u> ALL re-enrollment steps must be complete by 3/1/18 to receive \$250 <i>PRIORITY</i> enrollment fee discount. Re-enrollment completed after 3/1/18 and on or before 5/1/18 will receive a \$100 enrollment fee discount.</p>	<p>\$500/Family \$250 PRIORITY discount <i>by 3/1/18</i> \$100 discount by 5/1/18 <i>due upon enrollment/ re-enrollment</i></p>
Enhancement Fee	By volunteering in the school community beginning July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019, this yearly fee is reimbursed to the family's account at the rate of \$15 per volunteer hour.	<p>\$150/Family <i>due upon enrollment/ re-enrollment</i></p>
Student Fee	This yearly fee covers the cost of student yearbook, ASB ID card, admission to home sporting events, emergency preparedness materials and required standardized testing expenses. This fee is also used to cover expenses for classroom supplements, co-curricular programs, the all high school annual retreat, costs related to school spirit and student life activities, and subsidizes grade specific field trips.	<p>\$600/student <i>due by June 1</i> <i>or upon enrollment/ re-enrollment</i></p>
Textbooks	Upper school students are responsible for purchasing their own books through the school's book distributor, from other students or from online sources. The amount of purchase depends on the student's class schedule and from where the books are purchased.	<p>Varies</p>
Athletic Fees	Athletic Fees are applied per sport and are due prior to the student's first practice . Additional expenses for spirit packs and uniforms may apply. PE Uniforms are required for all students in PE classes and can be purchased in the front office.	<p>\$200-\$250/Sport \$20/PE Uniform Set</p>
Bus Transportation	Morning bus transportation is available for students in grades K – 12. Bus stops include: San Jacinto, Beaumont, Yucaipa, as well as a shuttle service from the Tennessee Street Campus to the Church Street Campus. The fee is non-refundable and a separate bus transportation agreement is required upon enrollment. Bus transportation services are dependent upon obtaining sufficient ridership.	<p>Varies <i>(Fees are based on specific bus stop and number of siblings)</i></p>
Miscellaneous Fees/Costs	Additional costs include technology expenses, special instructional supplies, replacement locks, band and choir attire, choir tour, instrumental class fees, yearbook convention, expenses relating to field trips and class trips, AP exams, class pictures, graduation, and special events.	<p>Varies</p>
