<b>Family/Student Fees</b>		
	<b><u>New Families:</u></b> This <i>nonrefundable</i> fee is paid at the time of initial application.	
<b>Application Fee</b>	<b><u>Currently Enrolled Families:</u></b> Application Fees are waived for families with a currently enrolled student in the RCS system as long as the New Sibling Application is submitted by 2/1/2019 (a \$50 fee will apply for new sibling applications received after this date).	<b>\$150/First Student \$50/Each Sibling <i>due with application</i></b>
	This <i>nonrefundable</i> fee is paid <b>yearly</b> , is due at the time of enrollment/re-enrollment, and holds the student's class placement.	
<b>Enrollment Fee</b>	<b><u>New Families:</u></b> New Student Application must be submitted by 3/1/19 to receive <i>PRIORITY</i> enrollment fee discount of \$250 (for new families enrolling a first child in grades K-12). Applications received after 3/1/19 and on or before 5/1/19, will receive a \$100 enrollment fee discount.  <b><u>Currently Enrolled Families:</u></b> <b>ALL</b> re-enrollment steps must be complete by 3/1/19 to receive \$250 <i>PRIORITY</i> enrollment fee discount. Re-enrollment completed after 3/1/19 and on or before 5/1/19 will receive a \$100 enrollment fee discount.	<b>\$500/Family \$250 <i>PRIORITY</i> discount by 3/1/19 \$100 discount by 5/1/19 <i>due upon enrollment/ re-enrollment</i></b>
<b>Enhancement Fee</b>	By volunteering in the school community beginning July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020, this <b>yearly fee</b> is reimbursed to the family's account at the rate of \$15 per volunteer hour.	<b>\$150/Family <i>due upon enrollment/ re-enrollment</i></b>
<b>General Student Fee</b>	This <b>yearly fee</b> covers the cost of the student yearbook, admission to home sporting events, emergency preparedness materials, and required standardized testing expenses. This fee also covers expenses for classroom supplements, co-curricular programs, book rentals, 6 <sup>th</sup> grade science camp, the annual retreat for grades 7 and 8, and expenses related to promotion.	<b>\$375/student <i>due by June 1 or upon enrollment/ re-enrollment</i></b>
<b>Technology Student Fee</b>	This <b>yearly fee</b> covers the cost of your student's Chromebook, relevant software, and support services. For students enrolling in grade 6 and continuing through grade 8, this yearly fee covers the entire cost of the Chromebook (including software). For students enrolling in grade 7 or 8, a buyout option will be available.	<b>\$165/student <i>due by June 1 or upon enrollment/ re-enrollment</i></b>
<b>Athletic Fees</b>	Athletic Fees are only applicable for Middle School Football. The fee is <b>due prior to the student's first practice</b> . Additional expenses for uniforms may apply. PE Uniforms are required for all students in PE classes and can be purchased in the front office.	<b>\$100 for MS Football \$20/PE Uniform Set</b>
<b>Extended Care</b>	Extended Care is available to students in grades 6 through 8 from 6:30-7:45 am and 3:00-5:30 pm and is prorated in 30 minute increments.	<b>Extended Care - \$5/hour</b>
<b>Bus Transportation</b>	Morning bus transportation is available for students in grades K – 12. The fee is non-refundable and a separate bus transportation agreement is required upon enrollment. Bus transportation services are dependent upon obtaining sufficient ridership.	<b>Varies <i>(Fees based on bus stop and number of siblings)</i></b>
<b>Miscellaneous Fees/Costs</b>	Additional costs include special instructional supplies, replacement locks, instrument rentals and damage deposit, band and choir attire, expenses relating to field trips and class trips, class pictures, 8 <sup>th</sup> Grade Washington DC Trip, and special events.	<b>Varies</b>
