	<u>New Families:</u> This <i>nonrefundable fee</i> is paid at the time of initial application .	
Application Fee	<u>Currently Enrolled Families:</u> Application Fees are waived for families with a currently enrolled student in the RCS system as long as the New Sibling Application is submitted by 1/17/2023 (a \$50 fee will apply for new sibling applications received after this date).	\$150/First Student \$50/Each Sibling <i>due with application</i>
	This <i>nonrefundable fee</i> is paid yearly and is due at the time of enrollment/re-enrollment. This fee pays for yearly account administrative functions and also holds the student's class placement.	
Enrollment Fee	<u>New Families:</u> New Student Application must be submitted by March 1 to receive <i>PRIORITY</i> enrollment fee discount of \$250 (for new families enrolling a first child in grades K-12). Applications received after March 1 and on or before May 1, will receive a \$100 enrollment fee discount. <u>Currently Enrolled Families:</u> ALL re-enrollment steps must be complete by March 1 to receive a \$250 <i>PRIORITY</i> discount off of the enrollment fee. Re-enrollment completed after March 1 and on or before May 1 will receive a \$100 enrollment fee discount.	\$550/Family \$250 <i>PRIORITY</i> discount by March 1 \$100 discount by May 1 <i>due upon enrollment/ re-enrollment</i>
Enhancement Fee	By volunteering in the school community beginning June 1, 2023 through May 31, 2024, this yearly fee is reimbursed to the family's account at the rate of \$15 per volunteer hour.	\$150/Family <i>due upon enrollment/ re-enrollment</i>
Student Fee	This yearly fee covers the cost of the student yearbook, admission to home sporting events, emergency preparedness materials, and required standardized testing expenses. This fee also covers expenses for classroom supplements, co-curricular programs, book rentals, 6 th grade science camp, the annual retreat for grades 7 and 8, and expenses related to promotion. This fee also covers the cost of your student's Chromebook, relevant software, and support services. For students enrolling in grade 6 and continuing through grade 8, this yearly fee covers the entire cost of the Chromebook (including software). For students enrolling in grade 7 or 8, a buyout option will be available.	\$650/student <i>due by June 1 or upon enrollment/ re-enrollment</i>
Athletic Fees	There are no additional fees for sports, however, there may be expenses for spirit packs and uniforms. For Football, there is a \$100 helmet reconditioning fee due by the first practice. PE Uniforms are required for all students in PE classes and can be purchased in the front office.	\$20/PE Uniform Set
Extended Care	The yearly <i>discounted</i> Extended Care Plan is available for purchase beginning 5/1/23 through 8/1/23 (monthly payments available). This plan covers any amount of extended care during the regular school year excluding late charges. Drop-In Extended Care is available before school from 6:30am and after school until 6 pm; prorated in 30 minute increments.	Yearly Extended Care - \$2,100/year Drop-In Extended Care - \$8.50/hour
Miscellaneous Fees/Costs	Additional costs include split financial accounts, special instructional supplies, replacement locks, instrument rentals and damage deposit, band/choir attire, expenses relating to field trips and class trips, SOAR, class pictures, 8 th Grade Washington DC Trip, and special events. There is an additional cost for students who require an aide as part of their Special Education services; that cost is dependent upon the percentage of time an aide is required.	Varies
